
Dear Sergio:

Thank you for sending me your new address. Unfortunately I will not be visiting Chile in the immediate future. I should tell you that I expect to be leaving the Foundation at the end of June and at the beginning of the fall will be at the University of Texas. I will be writing you and Betty in further detail later.

In the meantime you should know that yesterday I received a note from the new Rector of the University of Concepcion, Ignacio Gonzalez Ginouvés, endorsing the proposal his predecessor, David Stitchkin, sent us almost immediately before his leaving the Rectoria. I will recommend support for the program during the coming year on the same basis as the year just past. A copy of the letter to Rector Gonzalez telling him of the Foundation's decision in this matter will, of course, be sent to you and Fernando Alegria.
